HOUSE BILL NO. 344

BY REPRESENTATIVES ARMES AND HENRY BURNS

1 AN ACT

2 To enact R.S. 56:104(B)(3) and 302.2(D), relative to fees for hunting and fishing licenses;
3 to provide relative to fees to be paid by surviving spouses of members of certain
4 military service branches killed in action; and to provide for related matters.

5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

6 Section 1. R.S. 56:104(B)(3) and 302.2(D) are hereby enacted to read as follows:

7 §104. License fees; reciprocity; exceptions

11 (3) Any resident of Louisiana who is the surviving spouse of a member of
12 the United States Armed Forces, the Louisiana Army National Guard, or the
13 Louisiana Air National Guard who was killed in action while in a combat zone, upon
14 showing identification and documentation satisfactory to the department, shall be
15 issued all hunting licenses and permits for a total fee of two dollars and fifty cents.

17 §302.2. Exception for certain residents, nonresidents, and military personnel from
18 purchase or possession of basic recreational and saltwater license

20 D. Any resident of Louisiana who is the surviving spouse of a member of the
21 United States Armed Forces, the Louisiana Army National Guard, or the Louisiana
22 Air National Guard who was killed in action while in a combat zone, upon showing

1 identification and documentation satisfactory to the department, shall be issued
2 recreational and saltwater fishing licenses for a total fee of two dollars and fifty
3 cents.
