2	To amend and reenact R.S. 11:2258(B)(2)(d), relative to the Firefighters' Retirement
3	System; to extend the time period during which a member may convert from regular
4	to disability retirement; to require the Public Retirement Systems' Actuarial
5	Committee to report on the effect of such conversions; to provide an effective date;
6	and to provide for related matters.

10	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
11	Section 1. R.S. 11:2258(B)(2)(d) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as

15	B. The board of trustees shall award disability benefits to eligible members
16	who have been officially certified as disabled by the State Medical Disability Board.
17	The disability benefit shall be determined as follows:

21	(d) The authority of a retired member or a Deferred Retirement Option Plan
22	participant to convert from a service retirement to a service connected disability
