AN ACT

Any such 19 person shall have all rights and powers granted to the mayor with regard to any such

1 meeting and shall have the right to vote for or in the stead of the absent mayor. In 2 addition, any such person shall be counted for purposes of a quorum. 3 B.(1) Each of the citizen members must be a registered voter in the area from 4 which he is appointed, and he must have been a resident of the area for two years 5 previous to his appointment. (2) Any person designated by the mayor to attend a meeting of the sewerage 6 7 and water board in his absence shall be a resident and qualified voter of the city of 8 New Orleans. 9 10 Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature 11 12 by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If 13 vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become 14 effective on the day following such approval.

Brossett HB No. 355

Abstract: Relative to the sewerage and water board of New Orleans, authorizes the mayor to designate a person to attend meetings of the board in his absence.

<u>Present law</u> (R.S. 33:4071) establishes the sewerage and water board of the city of New Orleans. Provides for the composition of the board, which includes the mayor of the city. Provides further with respect to the powers and duties of the board.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and additionally authorizes the mayor to designate a person to attend meetings of the board in his absence. Requires that the designee be an unclassified member of the mayor's administration. <u>Proposed law</u> grants the designee all rights and powers granted to the mayor with regard to the meetings. Further authorizes the designee to vote for or in the stead of the absent mayor and requires that the designee be counted for purposes of a quorum. Further requires the designee to be a resident and qualified voter of the city of New Orleans.

Effective upon signature of governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
