2	To amend and reenact R.S. 33:4071(B) and to enact R.S. 33:4071(A)(3), relative to the city
3	of New Orleans; to provide relative to the sewerage and water board of the city; to
4	provide relative to the authority of the mayor to designate a person to attend
5	meetings of the board in his absence; to provide relative to the qualifications and
6	powers and duties of any such person; and to provide for related matters.
7	Notice of intention to introduce this Act has been published
8	as provided by Article III, Section 13 of the Constitution of
9	Louisiana.
10	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
11	Section 1. R.S. 33:4071(B) is hereby amended and reenacted and R.S. 33:4071(A)(3)
12	is hereby enacted to read as follows:
13	\$4071. Creation and organization of sewerage and water board

16	(3) If the mayor is unable to attend a meeting of the sewerage and water
17	board, he may be represented at any such meeting by a person designated by the
18	mayor who shall be an unclassified member of the mayor's administration. Any such
19	person shall have all rights and powers granted to the mayor with regard to any such
20	meeting and shall have the right to vote for or in the stead of the absent mayor. In
21	addition, any such person shall be counted for purposes of a quorum.

1	B. (1) Each of the citizen members must be a registered voter in the area from
2	which he is appointed, and he must have been a resident of the area for two years
3	previous to his appointment.
4	(2) Any person designated by the mayor to attend a meeting of the sewerage
5	and water board in his absence shall be a resident and qualified voter of the city of
6	New Orleans.
7	* * *
8	Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not
9	signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature
10	by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If
11	vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become
12	effective on the day following such approval.
