JUDGES/JUSTICE OF PEACE: Provides for the territorial jurisdiction and election districts of the justice of the peace courts and constables in LaSalle Parish

AN ACT

2 To amend and reenact R.S. 13:2618, relative to the LaSalle Parish justice of the peace 3 courts; to provide for the territorial jurisdiction of such courts; to provide relative to 4 the election to the offices of justice of the peace and constable; to provide for 5 effectiveness; and to provide for related matters. 6 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana: 7 Section 1. R.S. 13:2618 is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows: 8 §2618. Territorial jurisdiction; LaSalle Parish justice of the peace courts 9 A. Effective January 1, 2003, the The territorial limits of the justice of the 10 peace courts in LaSalle Parish shall be as follows: 11 (1) The first justice of the peace district and court shall consist of Precincts 12 1-1, 1-2, 1-3, <del>1-4,</del> 4-1, <del>and</del> 4-2, and 4-4. 13 (2) The second justice of the peace district and court shall consist of 14 Precincts 2-1,  $\frac{2-3}{2}$ , 3-1, 3-2, and  $\frac{3-3}{2}$  4-3. 15 (3) The third justice of the peace district and court shall consist of Precincts 16 7-1, 7-2, 8-2, 8-3, 8-5, 8-6, and 8-7, and 10-1. 17 (4) The fourth justice of the peace district and court shall consist of Precincts 18 5-1, 6-1, and 6-2, and 10-1.

(5) The fifth justice of the peace district and court shall consist of Precincts 2 9-1, 9-2, 9-3, 9-4, and 9-5, and 10-4. 3 B. The districts provided in Subsection A of this Section shall be effective 4 for election purposes with the opening of the qualifying period for the regularly scheduled 2002 2014 primary election for justices of the peace and constables, and 5 6 the persons elected to the offices of justice of the peace and constable for such justice 7 of the peace courts in LaSalle Parish at the next regularly scheduled election and 8 their successors shall be elected from the districts provided in Subsection A of this 9 Section. The provisions of Subsection A of this Section shall be effective for all 10 other purposes beginning January 1, 2015. 11 Section 2.(A) The precincts referenced in this Act are those Voting Districts (VTDs) 12 contained in the 2010 Census Redistricting TIGER/Line Shapefiles for the Parish of LaSalle 13 in the State of Louisiana. 14 (B) When a precinct referenced in this Act has been subdivided by action of the 15 parish governing authority on a nongeographic basis or subdivided by action of the parish 16 governing authority on a geographic basis in accordance with the provisions of R.S. 17 18:532.1, the enumeration in this Act of the general precinct designation shall include all 18 nongeographic and all geographic subdivisions thereof, however such subdivisions may be 19 designated. The territorial limits of the districts as provided in this Act shall continue in 20 effect without change regardless of any changes made to the precincts by the parish 21 governing authority. 22 Section 3. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not 23 signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature 24 by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If 25 vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become 26 effective on the day following such approval.

**Abstract:** Redistricts the justice of the peace courts and constable districts in LaSalle Parish.

<u>Present law</u> provides for five justice of the peace courts in LaSalle Parish. Each elects a justice of the peace and a constable.

<u>Proposed law</u> changes the territorial jurisdiction of the five justice of the peace courts in LaSalle Parish and therefore the election districts for justice of the peace and constable. (See attached map and statistics.)

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that the districts provided in <u>proposed law</u> shall be effective for election purposes with the opening of the qualifying period for the 2014 primary election for justice of the peace and constables and that the persons elected to the offices of justice of the peace and constable for such justice of the peace courts at the next regularly scheduled election and their successors shall be elected from the districts provided in <u>proposed law</u>. <u>Proposed law</u> provides that the districts provided in <u>proposed law</u> shall be effective for all other purposes on Jan. 1, 2015.

<u>Proposed law</u> specifies that precincts referenced in district descriptions are those precincts identified as Voting Districts (VTDs) in the 2010 Census Redistricting TIGER/Line Shapefiles for the Parish of LaSalle, state of La. Also specifies that if any such precinct has been subdivided by action of the parish governing authority on a nongeographic basis or subdivided by action of the parish governing authority on a geographic basis in accordance with <u>present law</u>, the enumeration of the general precinct designation shall include all nongeographic and all geographic subdivisions thereof. Further provides that the territorial limits of the districts as enacted shall continue in effect without change regardless of any changes made to the precincts by the parish governing authority.

Effective upon signature of governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
