Prefiled pursuant to Article III, Section 2(A)(4)(b)(i) of the Constitution of Louisiana.

VETERINARIANS: Authorizes the state veterinarian to quarantine any animal until certain inspections are completed

1 AN ACT

2 To amend and reenact R.S. 3:2094(2), relative to the state veterinarian's authority to
3 quarantine; to provide authorization for the state veterinarian to quarantine any
4 animal until certain inspections are completed; and to provide for related matters.

5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

6 Section 1. R.S. 3:2094(2) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:

7 §2094. Powers of the state veterinarian

8 The state veterinarian may:

9 * * *

10 (2) Place any ~~livestock~~ animal in quarantine until the necessary inspections,
11 ~~or~~ tests₂ or epidemiological investigations have been completed.

HB 358 Original 2015 Regular Session Schroder

Abstract: Authorizes the state veterinarian to place any animal in quarantine until the necessary inspections, tests, or epidemiological investigations have been completed.

Present law authorizes the state veterinarian to place livestock in quarantine until the necessary inspections, tests, or epidemiological investigations have been completed. Proposed law expands the authority to quarantine in present law to any animal.
