Abstract: Revises the number of members of the Workers' Compensation Advisory Council from 17 to 18 with the additional member being a representative of the La. Pharmacy Association.

CODING: Words in struck through type are deletions from existing law; words <u>underscored</u> are additions.

<u>Present law</u> provides for 17 members consisting of the following representatives: two representative of labor, two representative of business interests, one representative of self-insured industries in La., one attorney licensed in La. who has represented employers in workers' compensation claims, one attorney licensed in La. who has represented claimants in workers' compensation claims, one representative from the La. State Medical Society, five representatives from the general public, one representative from the La. Orthopedic Association, the director of the office of workers' compensation administration, one representative of the Chiropractic Association of La., one representative of the La. Psychological Association. All representatives are to be appointed by the governor and serve at his pleasure.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and adds an additional member to the Workers' Compensation Advisory Council who shall be a representative of the La. Pharmacy Association.
