HOUSE BILL NO. 366

APPROPRIATIONS/JUDGMENT: Appropriates funds for payment of judgment in the matter of "Lawrence Willis, et al. v. State of Louisiana, et al."

1 AN ACT

2 To appropriate funds out of the General Fund of the state of Louisiana for Fiscal Year 2010-  
3 2011 to be used to pay the consent judgment in the suit entitled "Lawrence Willis,  
4 individually and on behalf of the minor children, Lacey Elizabeth Willis and Laura  
5 Elizabeth Willis v. State of Louisiana Department of Transportation and  
6 Development"; and to provide for related matters.

7 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

8 Section 1. The sum of Thirty Thousand Seven Hundred Fifty and No/100  
9 (\$30,750.00) Dollars in favor of plaintiffs, Lawrence Willis, individually and on behalf of  
10 the minor children, Lacey Elizabeth Willis and Laura Elizabeth Willis; and Nine Thousand  
11 Six Hundred Twenty-Five and 54/100 (\$9,625.54) Dollars in favor of defendant/plaintiff in  
12 cross-claim, Louisiana Farm Bureau Casualty Insurance; both amounts to be apportioned and  
13 paid as follows: Seven Hundred Fifty and No/100 (\$750.00) Dollars to Lawrence Willis and  
14 his attorney, William Rick Warren; Thirty Thousand and No/100 (\$30,000.00) Dollars to  
15 Lacey Willis and her attorney, William Rick Warren; and Nine Thousand Six Hundred  
16 Twenty-Five and 54/100 (\$9,625.54) Dollars to Louisiana Farm Bureau Casualty Insurance  
17 Company and its attorney, Payne Williams; is hereby appropriated out of the General Fund  
18 of the state of Louisiana for Fiscal Year 2010-2011 to be used to pay the consent judgment  
19 in the suit entitled "Lawrence Willis, individually and on behalf of the minor children, Lacey  
20 Elizabeth Willis and Laura Elizabeth Willis v. State of Louisiana Department of

1 Transportation and Development", bearing Number 37,565-02 on the docket of the Eighth  
2 Judicial District Court, parish of Winn, state of Louisiana.

3 Section 2. This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2010; if vetoed by the governor  
4 and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become effective on July 1,  
5 2010, or on the day following such approval by the legislature, whichever is later.
