1 AN ACT

2 To amend and reenact R.S. 14:134.1(A) and to enact R.S. 14:134.1(C), relative to
3 malfeasance in office; to provide with respect to malfeasance in office involving
4 prohibited sexual conduct; and to provide for related matters.

5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

6 Section 1. R.S. 14:134.1(A) is hereby amended and reenacted and R.S. 14:134.1(C)
7 is hereby enacted to read as follows:

8 §134.1. Malfeasance in office; sexual conduct prohibited with persons ~~sentenced to~~
9 in the custody and supervision of the Department of Public Safety and
10 Corrections

11 A. It shall be unlawful and constitute malfeasance in office for any ~~person~~
12 ~~who is a law enforcement officer, officer of the Department of Public Safety and~~
13 ~~Corrections, or employee of any prison, jail, or correctional institution, or persons~~
14 ~~employed by entities operating work-release facilities of the Department of Public~~
15 ~~Safety and Corrections, of the following persons~~ to engage in sexual intercourse or
16 any other sexual conduct with a person who is under their supervision and who is
17 confined in a prison, jail, ~~work-release~~ work release facility, or correctional
18 institution, or who is under the supervision of the division of probation and ~~parole:~~
19 parole:

20 (1) A law enforcement officer.

21 (2) An officer, employee, contract worker, or volunteer of the Department
22 of Public Safety and Corrections or any prison, jail, work release facility, or
23 correctional institution.

1 C. For purposes of this Section, "law enforcement officer" shall include
2 commissioned police officers, sheriffs, deputy sheriffs, marshals, deputy marshals,
3 correctional officers, constables, wildlife enforcement agents, state park wardens,
4 and probation and parole officers.
