AN ACT

To amend and reenact R.S. 14:95.7(C), relative to the crime of possession or dealing in firearms with obliterated identification marks or serial numbers; to provide for increased penalties; and to provide for related matters.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

Section 1. R.S. 14:95.7(C) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:

§95.7. Possession of or dealing in firearms with obliterated ~~number~~ numbers or ~~mark~~ marks

C. Whoever violates the provisions of this Section shall be fined not more than one thousand dollars and ~~may be imprisoned for not more than six months.~~ imprisoned as follows:

(1) For a first offense, the penalty shall be imprisonment, with or without hard labor, for not less than one year nor more than five years.

(2) For a second or subsequent offense, the penalty shall be imprisonment, with or without hard labor, for not less than two years nor more than ten years.
