AN ACT

To enact R.S. 1:55(A)(8), relative to legal holidays for public schools; to provide that the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November in even-numbered years shall be a holiday for public schools in certain parishes; and to provide for related matters.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

Section 1. R.S. 1:55(A)(8) is hereby enacted to read as follows:

§55. Days of public rest, legal holidays, and half-holidays

A. The following shall be days of public rest and legal holidays and half-holidays:

* * *

(8) The first Tuesday after the first Monday in November in even-numbered years for public schools in any parish where the parish governing authority has established a polling place at a public school.
