AN ACT

SCHOOLS/BOARDS: Requires school board members to substitute teach

2	To enact R.S. 17:53.1, relative to requirements for school board members; to require each
3	member of a local public school board to substitute teach in a public school in the
4	school system in which the member serves each year of his term in office; to provide
5	that the school board member shall not receive compensation for such teaching; and
6	to provide for related matters.
7	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
8	Section 1. R.S. 17:53.1 is hereby enacted to read as follows:
9	§53.1. School board members; substitute teaching; required
10	Each member of a city, parish, and other local public school board shall
11	substitute teach in a public elementary and secondary school located in the school
12	system in which the school board member serves for three full school days each year
13	of his term in office. A member shall not receive compensation for such teaching.
14	Section 2. This Act shall become effective on January 1, 2012.

Tim Burns HB No. 403

Abstract: Requires each public school board member to substitute teach in a public school located in the school system where he serves three days each year. Provides that members shall not receive compensation for such substitute teaching.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires local public school board members to substitute teach in a public elementary and secondary school located in the school system in which the school board member serves for three full school days each year of his term in office. Prohibits a member from receiving compensation for such teaching.

Effective Jan. 1, 2012.
