2	To enact R.S. 17:7(29), relative to the duties, functions, and responsibilities of the State
3	Board of Elementary and Secondary Education; to require the State Board of
4	Elementary and Secondary Education to develop, adopt, and provide for the
5	implementation of a uniform grading scale for use in public schools; to provide for
6	enforcement and exceptions; to provide for a task force to provide recommendations;
7	to provide for rules and regulations; to provide for effectiveness; and to provide for
8	related matters.
9	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
10	Section 1. R.S. 17:7(29) is hereby enacted to read as follows:
11	§7. Duties, functions, and responsibilities of board
12	In addition to the authorities granted by R.S. 17:6 and any powers, duties, and
13	responsibilities vested by any other applicable laws, the board shall:
14	* * *
15	(29)(a) Develop, adopt, and provide for the implementation of a uniform
16	grading scale for use in public elementary and secondary schools and other public
17	schools and programs under its jurisdiction, which shall be enforced by the
18	governing authorities of public schools and by city, parish, and other local public
19	school superintendents except as otherwise provided by this Paragraph.
20	(b) The provisions of Subparagraph (a) of this Paragraph shall not apply to
21	any school operated by the United States Department of Defense that is located on
22	a federal military installation.
23	Section 2. During the 2010-2011 school year, the State Board of Elementary and
24	Secondary Education shall appoint a task force to provide input, recommendations, and

20	Section 3. By not later than the beginning of the 2011-2012 school year, the State		
21	Board of Elementary and Secondary Education shall adopt rules and regulations in		
22	accordance with the Administrative Procedure Act to provide for the implementation of the		
23	provisions of this Act.
