



Present law (Ch.C. Art. 896) provides that any time after the entry of an adjudication order, the court may suspend further proceedings and place the child on supervised or unsupervised probation.

Proposed law prohibits deferred dispositional agreements from being available in cases where the child has been convicted of distribution of any Schedule I, II, III, or IV controlled substances or a crime of violence.
