### 1 AN ACT 2 To amend and reenact R.S. 46:1095(B)(1) and (C) and to enact R.S. 33:2956, relative to 3 hospital service districts; to authorize and provide relative to investments of 4 foundations and similar entities created by the governing bodies of hospital service 5 districts; to provide relative to the appointment and term of service of certain 6 members of certain hospital service district boards of commissioners; and to provide 7 for related matters. 8 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana: 9 Section 1. R.S. 33:2956 is hereby enacted to read as follows: 10 §2956. Investments by foundations and similar entities created by hospital service 11 districts 12 A. For purposes of this Section, unless the context clearly indicates 13 otherwise, the following terms shall have the following meanings: 14 (1) "Foundation" means a nonprofit or not-for-profit corporation or other 15 entity created by the board of commissioners or comparable governing body of a 16 hospital service district for the purpose of financial support of the facilities and 17 programs of the hospital service district. 18 (2) "Funds of the foundation" means money or other things of value donated 19 to the foundation to support the facilities, programs, and activities of the hospital 20 service district the foundation was created to support but shall not include any funds 21 donated or provided to the foundation by the district or by any facility or program 22 of the district. 23 (3) "Hospital service district" means a district created by local, special, or 24 general law or created by a parish or municipality pursuant to general law for the

2	hospitals, for the care of persons suffering from illness or disability, administering
3	other activities related to health care provision or promotion, and otherwise

5	B. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, any foundation may
6	invest funds of the foundation as provided by law for investment of funds of the
7	Louisiana State Employees Retirement System, including but not limited to R.S.
8	11:263 and 267; however, any such investment may be made only in compliance
9	with rules and regulations established by the board of directors or other governing
10	board of the foundation, in compliance with rules and regulations established by the
11	board of commissioners of the hospital service district, and in compliance with the
12	provisions of R.S. 11:263 and 267 and any other law which provides for investments
13	in which funds of the Louisiana State Employees Retirement System may be

13	an interim successor to serve on the commission until the position is filled by the

16	Section 3. It is the intent of the legislature in enacting this Act that for purposes of
17	R.S. 24:175 the provisions of Section 1 of this Act shall be severable from the provisions of
18	Section 2 of this Act, and that the provisions of Section 1 of this Act shall be given effect
19	if Section 2 of this Act or any provision thereof is held invalid.
