JUDGES: Authorizes judges to practice law

1 AN ACT

2 To amend and reenact R.S. 13:1875(10)(c), relative to city court judges; provides relative
3 to the city court judges for the city of Monroe; to authorize judges of the City Court
4 of Monroe to engage in the practice of law after a certain date; and to provide for
5 related matters.

6 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

7 Section 1. R.S. 13:1875(10)(c) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:

8 §1875. Compensation of city judges; particular courts

9 The judges of the following city courts shall receive the salaries herein
10 provided:

14 (c) ~~Effective January 1, 1991, Until August 1, 2014,~~ the judges of the City
15 Court of Monroe are prohibited from engaging in the practice of law.
