PROBATION: Limits the number of active probation cases of a probation officer in Orleans Parish

1 AN ACT

2 To enact R.S. 15:571.20, relative to probation officers; to limit the number of active  
3 probation cases assigned to a probation officer in Orleans Parish; and to provide for  
4 related matters.

5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

6 Section 1. R.S. 15:571.20 is hereby enacted to read as follows:

7 §571.20. Limitation on active probation cases; Orleans Parish

8 Each probation officer in Orleans Parish shall be assigned no more than  
9 eighty-five active cases at any point in time.
