MTR VEHICLE/OFFICE: Provides OMV with authority to place advertisements on certain material

AN ACT

2	To enact Part XVII of Chapter 3 of Title 32 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, to
3	be comprised of R.S. 32:682, relative to the office of motor vehicles; to permit
4	placement of advertisements on the office of motor vehicles' mailings, facilities, and
5	website; and to provide for related matters.
6	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
7	Section 1. Part XVII of Chapter 3 of Title 32 of the Louisiana Revised Statues of
8	1950, comprised of R.S. 32:682, is hereby enacted to read as follows:
9	PART XVII. ADVERTISEMENTS
10	§682. Advertisement on Department of Public Safety and Corrections, office of
11	motor vehicles, mailings, public facilities, and website
12	A. The Department of Public Safety and Corrections, office of motor
13	vehicles, is hereby authorized to sell advertisement space on official mailings of the
14	office of motor vehicles, public facilities or websites owned or maintained by the
15	office of motor vehicles.
16	B. The department shall establish appropriate and reasonable fees for
17	advertisement on mailings, public facilities, and websites.
18	C. Fees collected for advertisements shall be forwarded to the state treasurer
19	for deposit into the Office of Motor Vehicles Customer Service and Technology
20	Fund and shall be used exclusively for the procurement of new technology. No fees

collected pursuant to this Section shall be used on existing technology within the
Department of Public Safety and Corrections, office of motor vehicles.
D. The Department of Public Safety and Corrections, office of motor
vehicles, shall adopt rules and regulations in accordance with the Administrative
Procedure Act, subject to oversight by the House and Senate committees on
transportation, highways and public works, as are necessary to implement the
provisions of this Section.

**Abstract:** Permits OMV to place advertisements on mailings, buildings, and websites.

<u>Proposed law</u> permits the Dept. of Public Safety and Corrections, office of motor vehicles, to sell advertisement space on official mailings of the office of motor vehicles and public facilities or websites owned or maintained by the department.

<u>Proposed law</u> permits the department to establish appropriate and reasonable fees for advertisement on mailings, public facilities, and websites.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that fees collected for advertisements shall be forwarded to the state treasurer for deposit into the Office of Motor Vehicles Customer Service and Technology fund and shall be used exclusively for the procurement of new technology. No fees collected shall be used on existing technology within the Dept. of Public Safety and Corrections, office of motor vehicles.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that the Dept. of Public Safety and Corrections, office of motor vehicles, shall adopt rules and regulations in accordance with the Administrative Procedure Act, subject to oversight by the House and Senate committees on transportation, highways and public works, as are necessary to implement <u>proposed law</u>.
