APPROPRIATIONS/JUDGMENT: Appropriates funds for payment of judgment against the state in the matter of "William Mothershead v. Matthew Davis, et al"

1 AN ACT

2 To appropriate funds out of the General Fund of the state of Louisiana for Fiscal Year 2011-
3 2012 to be used to pay the consent judgment against the state in the suit entitled
4 "William Mothershead v. Matthew Davis; Irby Construction Company; Old Republic
5 Insurance Company and Illinois National Insurance Company"; and to provide for
6 related matters.

7 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

8 Section 1. The sum of Two Thousand Five Hundred and No/100 (\$2,500.00) Dollars
9 is hereby appropriated out of the General Fund of the state of Louisiana for Fiscal Year
10 2011-2012 to be used to pay the consent judgment in the suit entitled "William Mothershead
11 v. Matthew Davis; Irby Construction Company; Old Republic Insurance Company and
12 Illinois National Insurance Company", bearing Number 109,406, Division E, on the docket
13 of the Twenty-First Judicial District Court, parish of Livingston, state of Louisiana.

14 Section 2. This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2011; if vetoed by the governor
15 and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become effective on July 1,
16 2011, or on the day following such approval by the legislature, whichever is later.
