AN ACT

To amend and reenact R.S. 9:2087(B), relative to trusts; to provide relative to the delegation of certain duties of a trustee; to provide that the delegation of authority for the sale of immovable property under certain circumstances shall be considered a ministerial duty; and to provide for related matters.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

Section 1. R.S. 9:2087(B) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:

§2087. Delegating performance

* * *

B.(1) A trustee may, by power of attorney, delegate the performance of ministerial duties and acts that he could not reasonably be required to perform personally.

(2) A written power of attorney in authentic form, executed by a trustee authorizing a mandatary to sell specifically described immovable property at a specific price shall be considered the delegation of the performance of a ministerial duty as provided by Paragraph (1) of this Subsection.
