PRIVATE SECURITY: Provides relative to entities practicing as licensed private security businesses

1 AN ACT

2 To enact R.S. 37:3294(C), relative to licensed private security business entities; to provide
3 for licensure for businesses; to provide for exceptions; and to provide for related
4 matters.

5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

6 Section 1. R.S. 37:3294(C) is hereby enacted to read as follows:

7 §3294. Sole proprietorship, partnership, corporation, association with licensed
8 business

9 * * *

10 C. Nothing in this Section shall be construed to render inapplicable any other
11 provisions of this Chapter.

HB 638 Engrossed 2024 Regular Session Muscarello

Abstract: Provides that private security licensure requirements for businesses shall not supersede any other private security regulatory and licensing laws.

Present law provides that businesses operating pursuant to present law shall not be prohibited from practicing through a partnership, corporation, or association.

Present law provides that at least one partner or corporate officer shall be licensed when the business's primary activity consists of providing services pursuant to present law.

Proposed law provides that no conflicting provision in present law shall render any other present law inapplicable.
