Abstract: Authorizes required remediation of an oilfield site.

<u>Present law</u> provides for the powers of the secretary of the Dept. of Natural Resources and the commissioner of conservation. <u>Proposed law</u> adds to those powers the authority to require a responsible owner to investigation, test, and remediate an oilfield site found to be a danger to the environment or a potential orphan site.
