STUDENT/SCH ATTENDANCE: Requires parents of public school students to reimburse public school boards for certain legal costs

1 AN ACT

2 To enact R.S. 17:154.2, to require parents to reimburse all court and other costs incurred by
3 a city, parish, or other local public school board relative to domicile violations for
4 public school enrollment; and to provide for related matters.

5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

6 Section 1. R.S. 17:154.2 is hereby enacted to read as follows:

7 §154.2. Parents; legal costs; domicile violations

8 A parent or legal guardian of a public school student shall reimburse the city,
9 parish, or other local public school board for all court costs and other costs incurred
10 by the local board if the parent or legal guardian is found by a court of competent
11 jurisdiction to be in violation of the domicile requirements for the enrollment of his
12 child in public school.

Abstract: Requires parents of public school students to reimburse local school boards for all costs incurred by the local board if the parent is found in violation of the domicile requirements for school enrollment.

Proposed law requires a parent or legal guardian of a public school student to reimburse the city, parish, or other local public school board for all court costs and other costs incurred by

the local board if the parent or legal guardian is found by a court of competent jurisdiction to be in violation of the domicile requirements for the enrollment of his child in public school.
