APPROPRIATIONS/JUDGMENT: Appropriates funds for payment of judgment in the matter of "David O'Quinn, et al v. State of Louisiana DOTD"

1 AN ACT

2 To appropriate funds out of the General Fund of the state of Louisiana for Fiscal Year 2011-  
3 2012 to be used to pay the consent judgment in the suit entitled "David O'Quinn and  
4 Wisa O'Quinn, et al v. State of Louisiana through the Department of Transportation  
5 and Development"; to provide for court costs; and to provide for related matters.

6 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

7 Section 1. The sum of Fifty Thousand and No/100 (\$50,000.00) Dollars, plus court  
8 costs in the amount of Two Thousand One Hundred Forty and 40/100 (\$2,140.40) Dollars,  
9 is hereby appropriated out of the General Fund of the state of Louisiana for Fiscal Year  
10 2011-2012 to be used to pay the consent judgment in the suit entitled "David O'Quinn and  
11 Wisa O'Quinn, et al v. State of Louisiana through the Department of Transportation and  
12 Development", bearing Number 2003-4817-A on the docket of the Twelfth Judicial District  
13 Court, parish of Avoyelles, state of Louisiana.

14 Section 2. This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2011; if vetoed by the governor  
15 and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become effective on July 1,  
16 2011, or on the day following such approval by the legislature, whichever is later.
