PROPERTY/RIGHTS: Provides for the right to install solar energy devices

AN ACT

2	To enact R.S. 9:1255, relative to the installation of solar collectors; to provide for
3	definitions; to provide for certain rights and prohibitions relative to the installation
4	of solar collectors; to provide for exceptions; and to provide for related matters.
5	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
6	Section 1. R.S. 9:1255 is hereby enacted to read as follows:
7	§1255. Solar collectors; right of use
8	A. For purposes of this Section, "solar collector" means any device or
9	combination of elements which relies on sunlight as an energy source.
10	B. No person or entity shall unreasonably restrict the right of a property
11	owner to install or use a solar collector.
12	C. The provisions of this Section shall not supersede zoning restrictions,
13	servitudes as provided by Civil Code Article 697 et seq., or building restrictions, as
14	provided by Civil Code Article 775 et seq., which require approval prior to the
15	installation or use of solar collectors.
16	D. The provisions of this Section shall not apply to property or areas which
17	have been identified as historic districts, historical preservations or landmarks by any
18	historic preservation district commission, landmarks commission, or the planning or
19	zoning commission of a governing authority.

Foil HB No. 751

Abstract: Prohibits the unreasonable restriction of the right of a property owner to install solar collectors.

<u>Proposed law</u> defines "solar collector" as any device or combination of elements which relies on sunlight as an energy source.

<u>Proposed law</u> prohibits any person or entity from unreasonably restricting the right of a property owner to install a solar collector.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that the provisions of <u>proposed law</u> shall not supersede zoning restrictions, servitudes, or building restrictions which require approval prior to the installation or use of solar collectors.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that the provisions of <u>proposed law</u> shall not apply to property or areas which have been identified as historic districts, historical preservations or landmarks by any historic preservation district commission, landmarks commission, or the planning or zoning commission of a governing authority.
