LABOR: Prohibits noncompete clauses or restrictive covenants in employment contracts or agreements governing the business relationship between an employee physician and his employer

AN ACT

2	To enact R.S. 23:921(M), relative to employment contracts; to prohibit any noncompete
3	contract or restrictive covenant between a physician and his employer; to provide
4	definitions; and to provide for related matters.
5	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
6	Section 1. R.S. 23:921(M) is hereby enacted to read as follows:
7	§921. Restraint of business prohibited; restraint on forum prohibited; competing
8	business; contracts against engaging in; provisions for
9	* * *
10	M.(1) There shall be no contract or agreement or provision entered into by
11	a physician and his employer restraining him from practicing medicine.
12	(2) For the purposes of this Subsection:
13	(a) "Employer" shall mean any medical practice, hospital, clinic, physician,
14	or nonphysician that employs or contracts with a physician. "Employer" shall not
15	mean a partner or medical group practice in which the physician has ownership
16	interests.
17	(b) "Physician" shall mean any person holding a valid certificate to practice
18	medicine issued pursuant to R.S. 37:1274.

**Abstract:** Prohibits any noncompete contract between a physician and his employer which may restrict the physician's ability to practice medicine.

<u>Present law</u> provides for the prohibition of contracts that limit a person's ability to exercise a lawful profession, trade, or business of any kind.

Present law provides for exceptions to the prohibition against noncompete agreements.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that a physician and his employer may not enter into any contract or agreement that would prohibit the physician from practicing medicine.

<u>Proposed law</u> defines "employer" to mean any medical practice, hospital, clinic, physician, or nonphysician that employs or contracts with a physician. <u>Proposed law</u> further provides that "employer" shall not mean a partner or medical group practice in which the physician has ownership interests.

Proposed law defines "physician" as it is defined in present law (R.S. 37:1301(A)(4)).
