## MEDICAID: Requires the Medicaid program to reimburse providers for the vagus nerve stimulator and similar devices at rates which equal at least the cost of such devices

1	AN ACT
2	To enact Chapter 56-A of Title 46 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, to be
3	comprised of R.S. 46:2725 and 2726, relative to medical equipment covered by the
4	Medicaid program; to establish minimum Medicaid reimbursement rates for certain
5	covered medical equipment; and to provide for related matters.
6	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
7	Section 1. Chapter 56-A of Title 46 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950,
8	comprised of R.S. 46:2725 and 2726, is hereby enacted to read as follows:
9	CHAPTER 56-A. REIMBURSEMENT FOR ESSENTIAL MEDICAL EQUIPMENT
10	<u>§2725. Purpose</u>
11	The purpose of this Chapter is to remove unnecessary obstacles to treatment
12	of Louisiana Medicaid recipients when such treatment includes durable medical
13	equipment certified as "reasonable and necessary" pursuant to any Nationally
14	Covered Indications issued by the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services of
15	the United States Department of Health and Human Services, referred to hereafter
16	in this Chapter as "CMS".
17	§2726. Devices used in the treatment of seizures; reimbursement rate
18	The Department of Health and Hospitals shall ensure that when a health care
19	provider participating in the Medicaid program implants a vagus nerve stimulator or
20	other device deemed by CMS to be reasonable and necessary for treatment of a

- 1 patient with medically refractory partial onset seizures for whom surgery is not
- 2 recommended or for whom surgery has failed, that provider shall be reimbursed for
- 3 <u>such device at a rate which is at least equal to the cost of the device.</u>

Abstract: Requires the Medicaid program to reimburse providers for the vagus nerve stimulator and similar devices at rates which equal at least the cost of such devices.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that the purpose of <u>proposed law</u> is to remove unnecessary obstacles to treatment of Medicaid recipients when such treatment includes durable medical equipment certified as "reasonable and necessary" by the federal Medicaid agency.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that DHH shall reimburse providers for the vagus nerve stimulator or other device which is reasonable and necessary for treatment of certain types of seizures at a rate which is at least equal to the cost of the device.
