WILDLIFE & FISHERIES DEP: Authorizes the issuance of a restricted hunter education certificate for developmentally disabled hunters

2 To amend and reenact R.S. 56:699.5, relative to hunter education; to provide for exceptions

to the requirement for hunter education; and to provide for related matters.

Section 1. R.S. 56:699.5 is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:

§699.5. Firearm and hunter education requirement

A. No person shall hunt with a firearm unless that person has first been issued a certificate of satisfactory completion of a firearm and hunter education course taught or approved by the department, or possesses a valid hunting license issued by the department. However, a person under sixteen years of age may hunt without such certificate if he is accompanied by and is under the direct supervision of a person who is eighteen years of age or older and has a valid hunting license or proof of successful completion of a hunter safety education course approved by the department.

B. A person who is developmentally disabled and unable to successfully complete a hunter safety course may be issued a restricted hunter education certificate that permits him to hunt, if he is accompanied by and is under the direct supervision of a person who is eighteen years of age or older and has a valid hunting license or proof of successful completion of a hunter safety education course

1 approved by the department. Documentation of the developmental disability from 2 a licensed medical doctor shall be presented prior to the issuance of a restricted 3 hunter education certificate. 4 <u>C.</u> For the purposes of this <del>Subsection</del> <u>Section</u>, "direct supervision" means 5 that the person being supervised shall be within a normal audible voice proximity and in direct line of sight of the supervising adult at all times while hunting. 6 7 B. D. The commission may adopt rules to implement the provisions of this 8 Section, including rules to define the circumstances that constitute a person being 9 accompanied by and under the direct supervision of another.

**Abstract:** Authorizes the issuance of a restricted hunter education certificate for developmentally disabled hunters.

<u>Present law</u> prohibits any person from hunting without either completing a firearm and hunter education course taught or approved by Dept. of Wildlife and Fisheries or possessing a valid hunting license. Excepts from this prohibition a person under 16 who is hunting under the direct supervision of a person who is at least 18 and who has a valid hunting license or who has passed the hunter safety education course.

<u>Present law</u> defines "direct supervision" to mean the person being supervised is within a normal audible voice proximity and in the direct line of sight of the supervising adult at all times while hunting.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and authorizes the issuance of a restricted hunter education certificate to a developmentally disabled person who is unable to successfully complete a hunter safety course. Such permit allows a person to hunt if he is accompanied by and is under the direct supervision of a person who is 18 years of age or older and has a valid hunting license or proof of successful completion of a hunter safety education course.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires documentation of the developmental disability prior to the issuance of a restricted hunter education certificate.
