1 AN ACT 2 To amend and reenact R.S. 32.300.5(C)(1), relative to the penalties for texting while driving 3 a motor vehicle; to increase the maximum fine for a first violation; and to provide 4 for related matters. 5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana: 6 Section 1. R.S. 32:300.5(C)(1) is hereby amended and reenacted as follows: 7 §300.5. Use of certain wireless telecommunications devices for text messaging 8 prohibited 9 10 C.(1) The first violation of the provisions of this Section shall be punishable 11 by a fine of not more than one three hundred seventy-five dollars. 12

Barrow HB No. 886

Abstract: Increases the maximum fine for a first violation of the texting while driving provision.

<u>Present law</u> provides that the first violation of the <u>present law</u> shall be punishable of a fine of not more than \$175.

Proposed law increases the maximum to \$300.
