6	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
7	Section 1. R.S. 30:2011(D)(3), 2014(A)(1), and 2054(B)(2)(a) are hereby amended
8	and reenacted to read as follows:
9	§2011. Department of Environmental Quality created; duties; powers; structure

11	D. The secretary shall have the following powers and duties:

13	(3) To delegate the power to grant or deny permits, licenses, registrations,
14	variances, or compliance schedules to the appropriate assistant secretary. The
15	authority to execute minor permit actions and to issue registrations, certifications,
16	notices of deficiency, and notification of inclusion under a general permit or
17	regulatory permit may be delegated by the secretary or the appropriate assistant
18	secretary to an authorized representative, notwithstanding the provisions of R.S.

21	§2014. Permits, licenses, registrations, variances, and monitoring fees
22	A.(1) All permits, licenses, registrations, variances, and compliance
23	schedules authorized by this Subtitle shall be granted by the secretary. The power
24	to grant or deny permits, licenses, registrations, variances, or compliance schedules
25	may be delegated by the secretary to the appropriate assistant secretary, subject to

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1	his continuing oversight. The authority to execute minor permit actions and to issue
2	registrations, certifications, notices of deficiency, and notification of inclusion under
3	a general permit or a regulatory permit may be delegated by the secretary or the

9	B. The secretary shall have the following powers and duties:

11	(2)(a) To develop permitting procedures and regulations conforming to
12	applicable state and federal laws, and to require and issue permits, licenses,
13	variances, or compliance schedules for all sources of air contaminants within the
14	state of Louisiana and when the secretary deems it advisable to delegate the power
15	to issue or deny such permits, licenses, variances, or compliance schedules to the
16	appropriate assistant secretary subject to his continuing oversight. The authority to
17	execute minor permit actions, to issue registrations, certifications, notices of
18	deficiency, and notification of inclusion under a general permit or a regulatory
19	permit may be delegated by the secretary or the appropriate assistant secretary to an
20	authorized representative, notwithstanding the provisions of R.S. 30:2050.26.
