1 AN ACT 2 To amend and reenact R.S. 18:402(B)(2), (E)(1)(introductory paragraph) and (b) and (2)(b), 3 and (F)(2), 1272(A), 1285(B)(1)(a), and 1300(C)(1), relative to elections; to provide 4 for election dates; to provide for certain deadlines relative to special elections and 5 bond, tax, and other elections at which a proposition or question is to be submitted to the voters; to provide for effectiveness; and to provide for related matters. 6 7 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana: 8 Section 1. R.S. 18:402(B)(2), (E)(1)(introductory paragraph) and (b) and (2)(b), and 9 (F)(2) and 1272(A) are hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows: 10 §402. Dates of primary and general elections 11 * 12 B. Congressional elections. Elections for members of congress and officers 13 elected at the same time as members of congress shall be held every two years, 14 beginning in 1982. 15 16 (2) General elections for members of congress and officers elected at the 17 same time as members of congress shall be held on the first fifth Saturday in 18 December after the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November of an election 19 year. 20 * 21 E. Special elections to fill newly created office or vacancy in office. An 22 election to fill a newly created office or vacancy in an existing office, except the office of representative in congress, shall be held on the dates fixed by the 23 24 appropriate authority in the proclamation ordering a special election as follows:

1	(1) A special primary election shall be held on the first of the following days
2	that is not less than eleven weeks after the date on which the proclamation calling the
3	special primary election was issued, provided that the proclamation was issued at
4	least four weeks prior to the opening of the qualifying period for the special primary

8	general election is held on the first <u>fifth</u> Saturday in December <u>after the first Tuesday</u>

16	F. Bond, tax, or other elections. Every bond, tax, or other election at which
17	a proposition or question is to be submitted to the voters shall be held only on one
18	of the following dates:

20	(2) The first Saturday in October or the <u>The</u> first Tuesday after the first
21	Monday in November or the fifth Saturday after the first Tuesday after the first
22	Monday in November of even-numbered years.

24	§1272. United States senators; representatives in congress; time of electing
25	A. All general elections for representatives in congress shall be held on the
26	first fifth Saturday in December, after the first Tuesday after the first Monday in
27	November in even-numbered years. The primary election shall be held on the first
28	Tuesday after the first Monday in November of an election year.

1	Section 2. R.S. 18:1285(B)(1)(a) and 1300(C)(1) are hereby amended and reenacted
2	to read as follows:
3	§1285. Notice of election

5	B.(1)(a) Written notice of the election and the certificate required by
б	Subparagraph (b) of this Paragraph shall be transmitted to the secretary of state and
7	each clerk of court and registrar of voters in the area affected by the election. If the
8	election is to be held on a primary election date, then such notice and certificate shall
9	be received by the secretary of state on or before the seventy-first day at least four
10	weeks prior to the opening of the qualifying period for the primary election. If the
11	election is not to be held on a primary election date, then the notice and certificate
12	shall be received by the secretary of state on or before the forty-sixth day prior to the
13	election. The secretary of state shall not accept any revisions to propositions,
14	including but not limited to changes in title, text, or numerical designations, after the
15	last day for submission of the notice and certificate to the secretary of state.

17	§1300. Procedures; notice of election; expenses

19	C.(1) When an election is called under the provisions of this Chapter, written
20	notice of the election shall be transmitted to the secretary of state, the commissioner
21	of elections, and each clerk of court and registrar of voters in the area affected by the
22	election. If the election is to be held on a primary election date, then such notice
23	shall be received by the secretary of state on or before the seventy-first day at least
24	four weeks prior to the opening of the qualifying period for the primary election. If
25	the election is not to be held on a primary election date, then such notice shall be
26	received by the secretary of state on or before the forty-sixth day prior to the
27	election.

29	Section 3.(A) This Section and Section 1 of this Act shall become effective upon
30	signature of this Act by the governor or, if not signed by the governor, upon expiration of

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- 1 the time for bills to become law without signature by the governor, as provided by Article
- 2 III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If this Act is vetoed by the governor and
- 3 subsequently approved by the legislature, this Section and Section 1 of this Act shall become
- 4 effective on the day following such approval.

(B) Section 2 of this Act shall become effective on January 1, 2013.
