| 7 | A. This Chapter shall be referred to and cited as the "Louisiana Workers' |
| 8 | Compensation Law". |
| 9 | B. The legislature hereby declares that the laws pertaining to workers' |
| 10 | compensation are to be construed in accordance with the basic principles of statutory |
| 11 | construction and not in favor of one party over another. |
| 12 | C. The burden of proof in disputes concerning workers' compensation cases |
| 13 | shall be by a preponderance of the evidence and shall be on the person seeking relief |
| 14 | pursuant to the provisions of this Chapter, unless otherwise specifically provided by |
| 15 | applicable provisions in this Chapter. |
| 16 | D. Unless a presumption of fact is specifically provided under this Chapter, |
| 17 | no presumption shall be established in favor of one party over another. |
| 18 | Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not |
| 19 | signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature |
