MTR VEHICLE/WEIGHT REGS: Provides for a special annual permit for overweight vehicles transporting crane equipment

1 AN ACT

2 To enact R.S. 32:387(C)(7), relative to special permits for heavy equipment carriers, permit  
3 fees, and authority of the secretary; and to provide for related matters.

4 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

5 Section 1. R.S. 32:387(C)(7) is hereby enacted to read as follows:

6 §387. Special permits

10 (7) The secretary may issue a special overweight permit for the operation of  
11 vehicles transporting crane equipment not to exceed one hundred fifty-two thousand  
12 pounds with eight axles. The permit fee shall not exceed three thousand eight  
13 hundred dollars. The permit shall specify the roads and highways over which the  
14 vehicle may operate. The secretary may promulgate rules and regulations in  
15 accordance with the Administrative Procedure Act as may be necessary to effectuate  
16 the provisions of this Paragraph.

**Abstract:** Provides for a special annual permit for vehicles transporting crane equipment.

Proposed law provides for the issuance of a special overweight permit for the operation of vehicles transporting crane equipment not to exceed 152,000 pounds with 8 axles. Specifies that the permit fee shall not exceed \$3,800. Requires that the permit specify the roads and highways over which the vehicle may operate. Authorizes the secretary to promulgate rules and regulations in accordance with the Administrative Procedure Act as may be necessary to effectuate the provisions of proposed law.
