20	to meet the two percent requirements of Subsections C, D, and E. The Commission
21	on Louisiana Commission of Weights and Measures may waive or extend the six-
22	month time period upon a finding that the quality or supply of bio-diesel or ethanol
23	is insufficient to allow blenders or retailers to meet the minimum content
24	requirements, or upon a finding that the motor fuel distribution terminals are or will
25	be unable to blend ethanol due to delays in obtaining permits or delays in
26	construction or installation of ethanol blending or storage equipment for reasons
27	beyond the control of the terminal owner or operator.

24	school which the pupil attends. Any type Type 2 charter school shall be considered
25	the local education agency for the purposes of any special education funding or
26	statutory definitions, while the local school board shall remain the local education
27	agency for any type <u>Type</u> 1, 3, or 4 charter school.

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§4001. Louisiana Charter School Start-Up Loan Fund; creation; purpose; distribution

A. The Louisiana Charter School Start-Up Loan Fund, hereafter referred to as the "fund", is hereby created within the state treasury for the purposes of providing a source for funding no-interest loans to assist both existing and new type <u>Type 1, type Type 2</u>, or type <u>Type 3</u> charter schools with initial start-up funding and for funding the administrative and legal cost associated with the charter school program.

10 C.(1) The State Board of Elementary and Secondary Education shall 11 administer the use of the monies appropriated from the fund and shall adopt rules in 12 accordance with the Administrative Procedure Act. The adopted rules shall specify that state board approval of any type Type 2 charter school proposal that includes 13 14 within its budget a request for loan funding which complies with the provisions of 15 this Section and details regarding how those loan funds are to be expended, shall 16 constitute the approval of that loan amount. No additional loan application paperwork shall be required. Any type Type 1 or type Type 3 charter school 17 18 approved by their local school board shall be required to submit no more than their 19 approved charter proposal and a detailed budget identifying how any loan funds are 20 to be expended and how such request complies with the provisions of this Section. 21 The state board may reject any such request which does not comply with terms of 22 this Section. Such rules shall also note that any loan funding may only be used be 23 used only to purchase tangible items such as equipment, technology, instructional 24 materials, and facility acquisition, upgrade, and repairs. Such equipment or other items shall become the property of the state if the loan is not fully repaid by virtue 25 26 of the school ceasing to operate during the three years of automatic loan repayment 27 as noted in Paragraph (3) of this Subsection.

(2) Loans shall be made only to type <u>Type</u> 1, type <u>Type</u> 2, and type <u>Type</u> 3
charter schools and shall not exceed one hundred thousand dollars to pay for charter

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1	school start-up and early operating expenses. No money lent as provided in this
2	Section may be used to pay prior debts of the nonprofit corporation which formed
3	the charter school, any of the natural persons principally involved in forming the
4	charter school, or any former or current business or nonprofit venture of any such
5	natural persons for any purchase not related to the creation of the charter school, or
6	to pay to members of the immediate family of any such natural persons, or to make
7	any investments.

10	legislative auditor to comply with the provisions of this Section relating to timely
11	audits.
12	(b) (ii) The Legislative Audit Advisory Council and the legislative auditor
13	have determined that the local auditee is unable to pay for an audit by a licensed
14	certified public accountant.

16	and failures to comply with laws and regulations.

5	(ii) At any time after a disaster or emergency is declared under the provisions
6	of R.S. 29:724(B)(1) which prevents an entity from completing its report within the
7	period prescribed in R.S. 24:513(A)(5)(i) Item (i) of this Subparagraph, the entity
8	may ask the legislative auditor in writing for an extension of time to complete the
9	report. The legislative auditor may approve the request at his discretion, subject to
10	the approval of the Legislative Audit Advisory Council.

13	statements and to examine, audit, or review the books and accounts of all private
14	water supply systems. The scope of the examinations may include financial
15	accountability, legal compliance and evaluations of the economy, efficiency, and

17	foregoing. In addition to the authority granted above, the legislative auditor shall
18	have access to and be permitted to examine all papers, books, accounts, records,
19	files, instruments, documents, films, tapes, and any other forms of recordation of all
20	private water supply systems, including but not limited to computers and recording
21	devices, and all software and hardware which hold data, are part of the technical
22	processes leading up to the retention of data, or are part of the security system.

24	means any private water system which receives local or state assistance in any fiscal
25	year and does not have audited financial statements prepared by licensed certified
26	public accountants. Assistance shall include grants, loans, transfers of property,
27	awards, and direct appropriations of state or local public funds. Assistance shall not
28	include guarantees, membership dues, vendor contracts for goods and services

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1	related to administrative support for a local or state assistance program, or benefits
2	to individuals.
3	(2) $(3)$ The financial statements of a private water supply system shall be
4	audited or reviewed by licensed certified public accountants subject to Paragraphs
5	(A)(5) and $(A)(6)$ (6) of this Subsection Section, but may be audited by the
6	legislative auditor pursuant to Paragraph (A)(4) of this Section. Any person
7	authorized to conduct an audit of a governmental entity pursuant to R.S. $\frac{37:88}{37:77}$
8	shall be permitted to audit the private water supply system subject to the approval
9	of the legislative auditor provided for in Paragraphs (A)(5) and $(A)(6)$ (6) of this
10	Section.

  - (b) Changes "cross-walk" and "cross walk" to "crosswalk" in Title 32.
  - (c) Repeals <u>present law</u> provisions for West Florida Commission which was terminated by law on Sept. 23, 2011.
  - (d) Removes error in <u>proposed law</u> that would have included deputy secretary for youth services (who reports directly to the governor) in provisions for deputy secretaries that report to the secretary.
  - (e) Provides that "sunset bills" from this legislative session will not continue any legislative authority repealed by the Act.
