

1 limited resources are used more effectively and efficiently; thus, all state expenditures
2 relative to public postsecondary education merit a thorough examination, including the
3 compensation of public postsecondary education system presidents and other system officers
4 and board members.

5 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby
6 urge and request that the Board of Regents conduct a study of the compensation of public
7 postsecondary education system presidents and other system officers and board members,
8 recognizing that such compensation encompasses not only base salaries but also personal
9 emoluments, including but not limited to car or housing allowances.

10 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the legislature requests that the Board of Regents
11 identify peer systems and the compensation of system executives based upon the most recent
12 data available from the Southern Regional Education Board, or if not available from the
13 Southern Regional Education Board, then from such reliable sources as the Board of Regents
14 selects.

15 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the legislature requests that the Board of Regents
16 report its findings to the House Committee on Education, the Senate Committee on
17 Education, and the Joint Legislative Committee on the Budget at least sixty days prior to the
18 convening of the 2017 Regular Session of the Legislature of Louisiana.

19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this Resolution be transmitted to the
20 commissioner of higher education and the chairman of the Board of Regents.
