

1 WHEREAS, owners and operators of public utilities and private facilities cannot act
2 to repair damaged poles or remove old poles no longer in service unless notice is received
3 regarding the status of the utility pole; and

4 WHEREAS, participation in a statewide utility pole reporting system would allow
5 the owners and operators of public utilities and private facilities to provide and receive
6 important information regarding the utility poles that are maintained in Louisiana.

7 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby
8 urge and request each owner or operator of a public utility or private facility, which
9 maintains or uses a utility pole in the state of Louisiana, to become a member of and
10 participate in a statewide utility pole reporting system.

11 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution be delivered to each
12 owner or operator of a public utility or private facility which maintains or uses a utility pole
13 in the state of Louisiana.
