4	WHEREAS, The Public Law Center, a joint venture of the Loyola and Tulane law
5	schools, launched the International Legislative Drafting Institute in 1995 in response to
6	increasing global demand for training of legislative drafters; and
7	WHEREAS, the Institute is a two-week summer program that responds to the
8	worldwide demand on legislative drafters for new laws to support the emergence of free
9	market economies and democratic forms of government and draws together diverse domestic
10	and international faculty members experienced in the legislative process; and
11	WHEREAS, more than five hundred participants from more than ninety-five
12	countries around the globe have graduated from the Institute, and staff members of The
13	Public Law Center have conducted training events in Europe, Asia, Africa, and the
14	Caribbean; and
15	WHEREAS, Institute participants have traveled to Baton Rouge to spend a day at the
16	Louisiana State Capitol, where they get a firsthand look at representative democracy; and
17	WHEREAS, staff members of the Louisiana Legislature have a long tradition of
18	assisting with the training of Institute participants, both in the classroom and during their site
19	visit to Baton Rouge; and
20	WHEREAS, the legislature recognizes the critical importance of the International
21	Legislative Drafting Institute and the lessons it imparts, the tremendous achievement of the
