HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 207

CULTURE/FRENCH: Requests the Council for the Development of French in La. to explore French immersion program options for children of military personnel

A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

2	To urge and request the Council for the Development of French in Louisiana to study and
3	explore French immersion program options for children of military personnel in
4	Louisiana.
5	WHEREAS, the Council for the Development of French in Louisiana (CODOFIL)
6	was created by the legislature in 1968 to promote, support, and enhance French language
7	immersion educational programs and instruction at all levels of elementary and secondary
8	education in the state; and
9	WHEREAS, the law further requires the council to develop a model French
0	immersion program which can be used by any school seeking to establish a French
1	immersion program within its curriculum and to increase the number of French immersion
12	schools in the state; and
13	WHEREAS, as stated in current law, R.S. 17:273.3, the legislature has found that:
14	(1) Research indicates that students who participate in foreign language
15	immersion programs, particularly French, demonstrate greater levels of proficiency in the
16	English language, higher overall academic achievement, and higher levels of self-esteem.
17	(2) Learning a second language has a positive effect on intellectual growth and
18	increased awareness of diverse cultures through access to history, art, and literature.
19	(3) Students in foreign language immersion programs have been shown to
20	demonstrate enhanced cognitive functions in solving complex problems and mathematical
21	computations through the development of more divergent and higher order thinking skills.

1 **(4)** In Louisiana, French language development and French language immersion 2 programs, in particular, provide a better understanding of the state's social traditions and 3 serve to promote, preserve, and develop our unique bilingual culture; and 4 WHEREAS, CODOFIL has been contacted by many United States military bases in 5 Louisiana which have expressed their interest in having the council explore the concept of 6 having French immersion programs or schools available for the children of the servicemen 7 and women stationed therein. 8 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby 9 urge and request the Council for the Development of French in Louisiana to study and 10 explore French immersion program options for children of military personnel in Louisiana. 11 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that CODOFIL is hereby urged and requested to 12 study and explore such options in an efficient and expeditious manner, to the extent possible, 13 in order to address the concerns of the military bases on this important educational initiative. 14 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that in fulfillment of this Resolution, CODOFIL is 15 hereby urged and requested to collaborate with local public school systems in which the 16 military bases are located. 17 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution be transmitted to the 18 president of the Council for the Development of French in Louisiana.
