16 Tech University; and

17 WHEREAS, Mr. Hanchey has ensured that so many of the university's programs,
18 activities, and events have been successful; and

19 WHEREAS, Reggie Hanchey is known as a true gentleman, always smiling and
20 always looking for opportunities to help out those in need; and

21 WHEREAS, recently, Mr. Hanchey was presented with a Distinguished Service
22 Award and Medal, only the twenty-fifth such award ever presented at Louisiana Tech.

23 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby
24 commend and congratulate Reggie Hanchey on forty years of dedicated and faithful service
25 to Louisiana Tech University and wishes him well on his retirement.
