

1 WHEREAS, the true virtue of lowering the tax burden imposed upon citizens by
2 government is that it expands individual liberty and thereby allows for greater economic
3 growth; and

4 WHEREAS, maximizing liberty is a more desirable societal goal than maximizing
5 tax revenues and government growth.

6 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby
7 memorialize the Congress of the United States and other state legislatures to pledge to return
8 government to its proper purposes and to reverse its encroachment into areas best served by
9 private individuals.

10 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the legislature hereby makes this same pledge.

11 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution be transmitted to the
12 presiding officers of the Senate and the House of Representatives of the Congress of the
13 United States of America and each member of the Louisiana congressional delegation.
