TRANSPORTATION: Requests study of four-laning Hwy. 190 from Tangipahoa Parish to East Baton Rouge Parish

A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

2	To urge and request the Department of Transportation and Development to study the
3	feasibility of adding two lanes to Highway 190, beginning at the Tangipahoa Parish
4	line and ending at the East Baton Rouge Parish line.
5	WHEREAS, Highway 190 is currently four lanes in East Baton Rouge Parish; this
6	study would research the cost-effectiveness and feasibility of adding two additional lanes
7	to the existing two lanes of Highway 190 across Tangipahoa Parish, thus connecting the two
8	parishes; and
9	WHEREAS, recent motor vehicle accidents on Interstate 12 westbound have caused
10	traffic to be diverted to Highway 190; and
11	WHEREAS, this increase in motor vehicle traffic on the westbound lane of Highway
12	190 has also caused an increase in motor vehicle accidents; and
13	WHEREAS, the addition of two lanes to Highway 190 would alleviate much of the
14	congestion problems experienced on Interstate 12.
15	THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby
16	urge and request that the Department of Transportation and Development study the
17	feasibility of adding two lanes to Highway 190 across Tangipahoa Parish, meeting with
18	Highway 190 in East Baton Rouge Parish.
19	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this study be conducted by the department prior
20	to December 31, 2012, and a report of its findings be presented to the legislature thirty days
21	prior to the convening of the 2013 Regular Session of the Legislature of Louisiana.
