

1 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby
2 urge and request each agency in state government to develop and implement employment
3 policies that remove questions about criminal history from the initial job application and
4 delay any background check until later in the hiring process for unclassified positions for
5 which a criminal background check is not required by law.

6 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a suitable copy of this Resolution be transmitted
7 to each statewide elected official and the chief executive officer of each department in the
8 executive branch of state government.
