SPECIAL DAY/WEEK/MONTH: Recognizes June as RV Centennial Celebration Month

1	A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION
2	To recognize the month of June as RV Centennial Celebration Month in the state of
3	Louisiana.
4	WHEREAS, throughout 2010, the Recreation Vehicle Industry Association (RVIA)
5	is leading an industry-wide, year-long celebration to recognize the one hundredth
6	anniversary of the RV industry with an array of centennial events and promotions to
7	highlight the RV industry's proud past and future; and
8	WHEREAS, the RVIA is designating the month of June as RV Centennial
9	Celebration Month as part of the year-long celebration of the RV industry's centennial; and
10	WHEREAS, RV Centennial Celebration Month is a focal point for the RV industry
11	to rally around as Americans are gearing up for summer and the vacation season; and
12	WHEREAS, even though the roots of RVing are as old as covered wagons and
13	camping itself, 1910 is the year that three prominent RV historians, renowned RV collector
14	David Woodworth, RV/MH Hall of Fame and Museum archivist Al Hesselbart, and
15	Smithsonian Institution curator Roger White, cite as the beginning of this uniquely American
16	industry; and
17	WHEREAS, the mass-produced, manufactured auto campers and camping trailers
18	first built in 1910 were the forerunners of today's RVs and gave birth to a way of travel that
19	has thrived throughout the years; and
20	WHEREAS, to mark the one hundredth anniversary of the RV industry, the RVIA
21	is spearheading numerous exciting initiatives, including an RV Centennial Media Tour with

- David Woodworth in April, which is slated to feature antique and modern RVs to showcase
- 2 the advancements the industry has made; and

- 3 WHEREAS, the RVIA is also hosting an RV industry party at the RV/MH Hall of
- 4 Fame and Museum in Elkhart, Indiana, on June 7, 2010, during the RVIA's 2010 Committee
- 5 Week and Annual Meeting, where industry representatives, media, and invited guests are
- 6 gathering to celebrate the RV centennial; and
- 7 WHEREAS, the RVIA is working to have official proclamations recognizing June
- 8 as RV Centennial Celebration Month at the national and state levels; and
- 9 WHEREAS, it is appropriate to set aside a special month in the celebration of the one
- 10 hundredth anniversary of the RV industry.
- 11 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby
- 12 recognize June as RV Centennial Celebration Month in the state of Louisiana.
- 13 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a suitable copy of this Resolution be transmitted
- 14 to the Recreation Vehicle Industry Association.
