10	have comprehensive review so that these provisions may be revised into a cohesive,
11	organized system of laws relative to the state capitol complex and the state capitol.
12	THEREFORE, the Legislature of Louisiana requests the House Committee on House
13	and Governmental Affairs and the Senate Committee on Senate and Governmental Affairs
14	to meet and to function as a joint committee to study the laws and issues related to the state
15	capitol complex and the state capitol and to report the findings and recommendations of the
16	joint committee to the legislature prior to September 1, 2013.
