COMMENDATIONS: Commends LSU gymnast Rheagan Courville upon being named the NCAA Vault National Champion for the second consecutive year

1 A RESOLUTION

2 To commend Rheagan Courville of the Louisiana State University gymnastics team for her  
3 outstanding accomplishments during the 2014 season.

4 WHEREAS, Rheagan Courville claimed a national championship in the vault on  
5 Sunday, April 20, 2014, in the individual competition with a score of 9.975, helping  
6 Louisiana State University achieve its record-breaking season; and

7 WHEREAS, this is Courville's second straight national title in the vault for the Baton  
8 Rouge native, who is the first Louisiana State University gymnast to win two national titles  
9 on vault; and

10 WHEREAS, with performances like that of Courville, the Louisiana State University  
11 gymnastics team with its third place finish is well on its way in the long journey to claim a  
12 national championship for the team; and

13 WHEREAS, such great accomplishments by Rheagan Courville and all of the  
14 gymnastics team are obtained with the excellent coaching of Head Coach D-D Breaux and  
15 all of her wonderful assistant coaches and staff.

16 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the House of Representatives of the  
17 Legislature of Louisiana does hereby commend Rheagan Courville of the Louisiana State  
18 University gymnastics team for her outstanding accomplishments and claiming a national  
19 championship in the vault during the 2014 season.
