COMMENDATIONS: Commends Wanda Huhn upon her installation as president of National Kappa Kappa Iota, Inc.

1 A RESOLUTION

2 To commend Wanda Huhn upon her installation as president of National Kappa Kappa Iota,  
3 Inc.

4 WHEREAS, Kappa Kappa Iota is the oldest professional organization for educators  
5 in the United States, having first been formed as a sorority for women educators in 1921 as  
6 the Order of the Blue Blue Violet in Oklahoma; the name was changed to Kappa Kappa Iota  
7 in 1931; in 1949, Kappa Kappa Iota was nationalized; and in 1995, National Kappa Kappa  
8 Iota, Inc., became a nonprofit organization; and

9 WHEREAS, the Louisiana Alpha Chapter of Shreveport was organized in 1951 and  
10 by 1954, five chapters coalesced to form Eta State, bringing Louisiana into the fold of the  
11 National Kappa Kappa Iota, Inc.; currently there are more than twenty chapters in Eta State  
12 with three hundred seventeen members; and

13 WHEREAS, the primary purpose of National Kappa Kappa Iota, Inc., is to promote  
14 the advancement of education by providing an effective network for the exchange of  
15 education and teaching practices by educators, and membership consists of state chapters,  
16 local chapters, and members-at-large; and

17 WHEREAS, in 1995, Ms. Wanda Huhn joined National Kappa Kappa Iota, Inc., and  
18 has worked faithfully and diligently since becoming a member; on the state level, Ms. Huhn  
19 has served as Eta State treasurer, chair of several committees, and two terms as Eta State  
20 president; she also has been elected to office in the national organization as recording  
21 secretary, third vice president, second vice president, and first vice president; and

1           WHEREAS, the majority of the more than two thousand eight hundred members of  
2 National Kappa Kappa Iota, Inc., have elected Ms. Huhn as their next national president, and  
3 her academic credentials merit such a post: from teaching high school mathematics, English,  
4 and computer classes in the mid-1980s, Ms. Huhn has advanced to her current post of  
5 professor at Louisiana State University-Shreveport in mathematics, instructing college  
6 students in algebra, geometry, math for elementary teachers, and math materials and  
7 methods; and

8           WHEREAS, in the years following its inception, National Kappa Kappa Iota, Inc.,  
9 has expanded its mission to include community and social projects, encouraging its members  
10 and member communities to support programs that provide shelter and counseling for  
11 victims of abuse and neglect; and

12           WHEREAS, when the national convention was held in Shreveport in 2011, Ms. Huhn  
13 as Eta State treasurer was instrumental in a books and bears donation drive that provided  
14 books to Shreveport's Community Renewal Program and bears to the Caddo Sheriff's  
15 Department, bringing smiles of joy to many children in the Shreveport-Bossier area; and

16           WHEREAS, the National Kappa Kappa Iota, Inc., annual convention's final event  
17 each year is a banquet at which its officers are installed, and at the organization's sixty-fifth  
18 convention in Atlanta in June of 2014, Ms. Wanda Huhn will be installed as president, and  
19 it is appropriate to commend her upon her election to this prestigious office.

20           THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the House of Representatives of the  
21 Legislature of Louisiana does hereby commend Wanda Huhn upon the occasion of her  
22 installation as president of National Kappa Kappa Iota, Inc., and does hereby extend best  
23 wishes for an especially effective and educationally prosperous term of office for Ms. Huhn  
24 and the organization.

25           BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a suitable copy of this Resolution be transmitted  
26 to Ms. Wanda Huhn.
