

1 Hospitals to engage in a cooperative effort with other public and private organizations and
2 institutions in establishing the Louisiana Center for Chronic Care Innovation, building on
3 the guidance provided by the Study Group on Chronic Care Management in the Community
4 in its February 2012 report to the legislature.

5 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the House of Representatives urges and requests
6 the Department of Health and Hospitals to help public and private partners establish the
7 Louisiana Center for Chronic Care Innovation, at no cost to the state, for the following
8 purposes:

9 (1) To prioritize, champion and stimulate implementation of the key
10 recommendations and strategies from the Study Group on Chronic Care management in the
11 Community.

12 (2) To study and disseminate evidence-based practices and concepts of chronic
13 care coordination.

14 (3) To provide a vehicle to move evidence from research to practice.

15 (4) To serve as a catalyst in enhancing interprofessional collaboration in chronic
16 care management initiatives.

17 (5) To convene collaborative summits and projects to enhance innovations in
18 chronic care management in the community.

19 (6) To seek grant and other funding opportunities for chronic care innovation in
20 Louisiana communities.

21 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Louisiana Center for Chronic Care
22 Innovation reports quarterly to the Study Group on Chronic Care Management in the
23 Community.

24 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution be transmitted to the
25 secretary of the Department of Health and Hospitals.
