## A RESOLUTION

To recognize the celebration of the National Day of Prayer at Mt. Calvary Baptist Church of New Iberia on May 3, 2018, and to encourage observance throughout the state of Louisiana.

WHEREAS, with eighteen members, Mt. Calvary Baptist Church of New Iberia was organized in 1875 under the leadership of the late Pastor John Berry Livingston, a native of Enterprise, Mississippi; and

WHEREAS, today, under the leadership of Pastor Mark Elliot Lewis, the church has continued to see tremendous growth in attendance, financial support, Sunday school attendance, and youth ministries; and

WHEREAS, through one hundred forty-three flourishing years and the succession of seven pastors, God has not left the midst of Mt. Calvary Baptist Church; and

WHEREAS, throughout the history of the United States of America, state and national leaders have deemed it appropriate and needful to recognize specific days of prayer; and

WHEREAS, the Continental Congress proclaimed the first National Day of Prayer on July 20, 1775, and did so for the purpose of looking to God for His aid and direction in the midst of the trying times of the nation's birth; and

WHEREAS, two-hundred forty-three years later, America is again in need of divine aid and direction of God's Hand as we seek to protect our citizens from natural disasters, racial unrest, mass murders, and heightened political division and polarization; and

WHEREAS, the theme for the National Day of Prayer in 2018 is "Pray for America— Unity"; and HR NO. 144 ENROLLED

WHEREAS, on May 3, 2018, the members of Mt. Calvary Baptist Church will celebrate the National Day of Prayer and hope that people of faith throughout Louisiana will join them in praying for unity.
