3 WHEREAS, Recommendation 13 further called for the Board of Regents to  
4 recommend to the legislature actions that will set aside, within the postsecondary education  
5 appropriations, a specific allotment of funds sufficient to enable the state's Historically Black  
6 Colleges and Universities to realize their important mission; and

7 WHEREAS Senate Resolution No. 185 of the 2010 Regular Session of the  
8 Legislature requested the Board of Regents to implement Recommendations 10(C) and 13  
9 of the Postsecondary Education Review Commission relative to the provision of equitable  
10 and sufficient funding necessary for the state's Historically Black Colleges and Universities  
11 to achieve their unique and important institutional mission.

12 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the House of Representatives of the  
13 Legislature of Louisiana does hereby urge and request the Board of Regents to report in  
14 writing to the House Committee on Education by not later than November 1, 2011, on  
15 actions taken by the board to implement Recommendations 10(C) and 13 of the  
16 Postsecondary Education Review Commission relative to the provision of equitable and  
17 sufficient funding necessary for the state's Historically Black Colleges and Universities to  
18 achieve their mission.

19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this Resolution be transmitted to the  
20 chairman of the Board of Regents and the commissioner of higher education.
