1 A RESOLUTION

2 To commend the McDonald's Restaurant on Plank Road in Baton Rouge upon the
3 celebration of its fiftieth anniversary.

4 WHEREAS, the McDonald's Restaurant on Plank Road, built in 1963, was the first
5 McDonald's built in the Baton Rouge community; and

6 WHEREAS, owner Charles Valluzzo and family have contributed much to the
7 success and flourishing of the restaurant; and

8 WHEREAS, the McDonald's Restaurant holds much history in that it survived a
9 hurricane in 1964 and began selling hamburgers to those in need until the restaurant ran out
10 of meat; for the remainder of the inclement weather period, the restaurant sold grilled
11 cheeses in order to provide food to the community; and

12 WHEREAS, McDonald's Restaurant has served as Ronald McDonald House
13 Charities' largest corporate donor for thirty-nine years; the charity's purpose is to create, find,
14 and support programs that directly improve the health and well-being of children; and

15 WHEREAS, the half-century anniversary celebration was held at the McDonald's
16 Restaurant located on Plank Road on May 16, 2013, and family, friends, neighbors, and
17 employees came to participate in the celebration and festivities; and

18 WHEREAS, McDonald's Restaurant merits a sincere measure of commendation upon
19 its fiftieth anniversary.

1 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the House of Representatives of the
2 Legislature of Louisiana does hereby commend the McDonald's Restaurant on Plank Road
3 upon the celebration of its fiftieth anniversary and extends best wishes for continued success
4 for many years to come.
